Julian Snelder is a New Zealander who has lived in Asia for the last 24 years. He has resided in China and India and has also worked extensively in other countries such as Japan, Korea, Taiwan and Indonesia. He has lived in Hong Kong for the last 15 years. He is a partner and co-founder (in 2005) of Amiya Capital, a global emerging markets investment hedge fund with almost US\$2 billion assets under management. Prior to Amiya Capital, he ran Morgan Stanley's technology banking unit in Asia, and for eight years before that was a management consultant at McKinsey & Company. He has first class honours bachelors' degrees in engineering (from University of Canterbury, New Zealand) and economics (from Trinity College, Cambridge).
